## BIRDS IN KENYA SAFARI

Climbing to 5,199 meters, Mount Kenya is the second tallest mountain in Africa. The scenery surrounding this designated World Heritage Site is breath-taking. It is pristine wilderness with lakes, tarns, glaciers, dense forest, mineral springs and a selection of rare and endangered species of animals, high altitude adapted plains game and unique montane and alpine vegetation. Visitors can enjoy mountain climbing, camping and caving with the mountain's rugged glacier-clad peaks providing the perfect backdrop.

### Sweetwaters Serena Camp, Ol Pejeta Conservancy

DAY 01

On arrival at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport, meet your driver guide and depart via Nairobi – Nanyuki to the Ol Pejeta Conservancy. Upon arrival, enter the reserve with a game viewing to the camp, check in and lunch is served. Later on, embark on an extended afternoon game drive.

#### Dinner and overnight - SERENA SWEETWATERS CAMP

*Ol Pejeta Ranch has created a reserve for chimpanzees working in close liaison with the Jane Goodall Institute. While chimpanzees are not native to Kenya, there are small threatened populations in the rainforests of neighboring Tanzania and Uganda and throughout central and western Africa. The Refuge at Ol Pejeta was designed as a safe haven for Central African chimpanzees that have been rescued from the bush and pet trade. All chimpanzees at Ol Pejeta were rescued from these conditions. They are now hiking on a large island in the center of the ranch, where they have formed a large social group. Visiting hours: 10.00 – 16.30h. The Ol Pejeta Conservancy hosts all the “Big Five” (elephants, rhinos, lions, buffaloes and leopards) and has a higher wildlife ratio than any other Kenyan National Park. Ol Pejeta is also concerned with the conservation of rhinos and houses the last two northern white rhinos in the world\*. The Conservancy employs highly trained rhinoceros conservation teams, partners with international veterinary specialists and ensures that the data is collected regularly on each individual animal. Steps like these ensure that we remain a role model for rhinoceros conservation in East Africa. \*Please note that the two remaining northern white rhinos can only be visited for an additional charge of US \$ 40 per person, this must be paid locally if requested by visitors. Visiting hours: 09-11.00 h & 15-17 h. But you can see black rhinos in the Ol Pejeta Reserve during the game drives! The Morani Information Center was named after the tame black rhino that used to live here. Over the years, Morani has been an icon of OlPejeta, an ambassador of his kind. He helped to raise awareness of the plight of black rhinos and other endangered species in the wild, and the*



Sanctuary, an area dedicated to the protection and population increase of rhinos and now around 50 Square kilometers and is located on the western border of the park. 40 white and 20 hike here black rhinos roaming free.

## Rhino Watch Safari Lodge, Solio Game Reserve

DAY 05

After breakfast, check out and drive to the Rhino Watch Lodge. Upon arrival at the Rhino Watch Lodge just deposit your luggage at the reception & collect your picnic lunch boxes, then approx 10.15h embark on a full day game drive in the private conservancy. Return to lodge and check in to your tent.

### Overnight and Breakfast - RHINO WATCH LODGE

The 'Solio Ranch' is one of the finest wildlife parks in Africa, which hasn't figured on the tourist map for generations. The park is a fenced, privately owned wildlife conservancy geared towards rhino conservation. The Solio Game Reserve was founded in 1970 when the owner of the Solio cattle ranch fenced off a large section of land and dedicated it to conservation. The park plays a major part in the protection and breeding of black rhinos in Kenya. Breeding has been so successful that rhino from Solio have stocked game reserves all over Africa. Scroll down to the bottom of the page for more information on the Solio Reserve and rhino conservation. The Solio Reserve is also an ideal place for bird watching. The acacia forest in the middle of the reserve is traversed by a river that at times turns into a swamp-like area. This habitat is a paradise for birds. Including the more than 300 species that are found in the game reserve are European rollers, flycatchers, and birds of prey such as vultures, eagle owls, Montagu's Harriers, long-crested eagles and buzzards. Also crowned cranes and the European stork can be found here.



## Lake Nakuru Lodge, Nakuru

Early breakfast & depart with a game drive en-route out of the ranch, exit and drive to Lake Nakuru National Park found in the Great Rift Valley. Upon arrival, enter the park with a game viewing to the lodge, check-in, lunch is served and relax in the garden. Later depart for an afternoon game drive in the park around the Alkaline Lake.

### Dinner and Overnight - LAKE NAKURU LODGE

Lake Nakuru is one of the Rift Valley soda lakes at an altitude of 1754 meters above sea level. It is surrounded by wooded and bushy meadows, and lies in the beautiful Lake Nakuru National Park. Visitors can enjoy the wide ecological variety and varied habitats ranging from Lake Nakuru to the surrounding cliffs and picturesque ridges. The Nakuru National Park is ideal for bird watching: flamingos, pelicans etc. and game drives where you will also see many wildlife. The park & lake are located in the south of the town of the same name. Area: 45 km<sup>2</sup>, average depth: 2.3m


## Lake Naivasha Sopa Lodge, Naivasha

DAY 07

Early morning game drive, return to the camp for breakfast then drive towards Lake Naivasha. Check in, lunch is served and relax in the garden. Later on, depart for an afternoon boat ride in the lake.

### Dinner and overnight - LAKE NAIVASHA SOPA LODGE

Naivasha is located at 1.884m in the "Great Rift Valley" the Great Rift Valley. The freshwater lake covers an area of 139 km<sup>2</sup> and is surrounded by a swamp covering an area of 64 square kilometers, but this can vary greatly depending on precipitation. The lake has an average depth of 6 m, with the deepest area on Crescent Island, maximum depth of 30 m.

Information Center was established to continue this education and keep the curiosity wild. The Morani Information Center offers visitors the opportunity to experience the different species of Ol Pejeta – from anatomy to behavior and habitat. It also provides an insight into the work of Ol Pejeta Conservancy – which is done on a daily basis to protect the wildlife and preserve the wildlife. There is also a converted rhino transport box to explore! This is a unique opportunity for visitors to get into the same box where several rhinos have been brought in over the years. See what a rhinoceros feels like when it moves, and be inspired by the appealing info graphics that contain all the info you need to know about rhinos. The center is open daily from 9am to 5pm and is free.



### Ashnil Samburu Camp, Samburu National Reserve

After breakfast leave the conservancy with game drive on the way out of the reserve, further via Nanyuki-Isiolo to Samburu Reserve. Upon arrival, drive into the game reserve Pirsch on the way to the camp. Room reference, Lunch and rest, followed by an extended afternoon game drive.

**Dinner and overnight - ASHNIL SAMBURU CAMP**

DAY 02

### Samburu Sopa Lodge, Samburu National Reserve

Early breakfast and extensive morning game drive, lunch at the lodge, rest and then extensive afternoon stalk.

**Dinner and Overnight - SAMBURU SOPA LODGE**

Set on the banks of the Ewaso Ng'iro River and neighbouring the Buffalo Springs National Park, Samburu National Reserve is characterised by a spectacular landscape of rugged hills, undulating plains and riverine forests. The park is home to abundant wildlife including a variety of rare species such as the reticulated giraffe, the long-necked gerenuk, Somali ostrich, Grevy's Zebra, and Beisa Oryx. Visitors can also enjoy spotting over 900 elephants, a variety of predators, and over 450 bird species. The ancient culture of the Samburu people is still alive here, and it is possible to see two unique customs firsthand. In the first, watch as herds of cattle respond to each man's individual voice as they call. In the second, see the tribesmen perform incredible dances that go back hundreds of years.



### IKweta Safari Camp, Meru National Park

Early breakfast, check out and depart with a game viewing from your lodge. Exit the park and proceed via Isiolo – Maua towards Meru National Park. (Approx. 3 ½hrs) Arrive at the camp for lunch and later embark on an afternoon game drive.

**Dinner and overnight - ASHNIL SAMBURU CAMP**

The Meru National Park has an area of 870km<sup>2</sup> and has a wide range of wild animals, including the African bush elephant, Masai lion, African leopard, cheetah, black rhinoceros and southern white rhinoceros, Grévy zebra, hippos. It often has brief rain showers and therefore usually has tall grass and partly lush swamps. The park is certainly known to many through the nature conservationists George and Joy Adamson and the lion Elsa, who raised them; the best-selling book and the award-winning film "born free!" Special mention should also be made of the Rhino
